Period Promise is devoted to making fundamental change so that we can eradicate period poverty in our communities. Part of that includes working with governments, businesses, unions, and other organizations to move the dial and change policy.

To support this, your United Way has created a policy agreement that partner organizations can sign, committing to provide free menstrual products to employees, guests, clients, and the general public.

The Period Promise Policy is a call-to-action for local businesses and organizations to provide no-cost period products in washrooms for staff, clients and customers.

Signing the Period Promise Policy – and placing free menstrual products in your washrooms – is one way you can help to address period poverty, de-stigmatize menstruation, and work towards helping more people get access to the products they count on.
